

**UPPER MACUNGIE TOWNSHIP
INFORMATION NEEDED FOR**

PATIO OR PATIO WITH ROOF PERMIT

Completed Upper Macungie Township application for permit signed by the Property Owner.

Site plan – Request an As-Built for your property. If your home was constructed after 1995, we should have one on file.

Show the position of the patio and all building & structures on the property, their sizes, and distances from the front (measure from the center of the road), side, and rear property lines.

Footings are required if the patio is to have a roof or any future structure built on top. A pavers patio does not need a permit but check with Zoning regarding impervious cover requirements.

Supply dimensional lumber sizes, spans of joists and girders, depth and width of footings and any other specification information for the structure you are building.

Contractors must supply a Certificate of Insurance showing liability and workers' compensation coverage or notarized insurance exemption form to the Township.

Homeowners do not need to supply proof of insurance.

Inspections required are noted with permit issue. Minimum required would be Footer, Frame, and Final.

Three sets of all documentation and one completed application needed to process.
