I am interested in attending the Upper Macungie Township Police Department Community Police Academy. I understand that I must be 18 years of age and a legal United States citizen. In addition, I understand that Upper Macungie Township residents will be given first priority for seating, which is limited to 30 cadets. Lastly, I understand that I may be released from the cadet class due to excessive (2 or more) absences.

The 2014 Community Police Academy will begin on Saturday, October 4th and continue every Saturday, with the final class scheduled for November 8th. Classes will begin promptly at 1000 hrs. (10:00 am) and conclude at 1200 hrs. (12 noon). Most of the classes will be held at the Upper Macungie Township Police Department headquarters located at 37 Grim Road, Breinigsville, PA 18031. All applicants will be subject to a background investigation. The Upper Macungie Township Police Department reserves the right to refuse admittance to those who have been convicted of a misdemeanor or felony in the last 5 years.
