**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF UPPER MACUNGIE,
LEHIGH COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 15
(MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC), PART 2 (TRAFFIC
REGULATIONS) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF UPPER MACUNGIE AMENDING NO TRUCK
TRAFFIC ON CERTAIN STREETS LOCATED WITHIN UPPER
MACUNGIE TOWNSHIP; SAID REQUIREMENTS BEING SET
FORTH MORE FULLY IN THE BODY OF THIS ORDINANCE.**

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Upper Macungie, Lehigh County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. ADDITIONS, INSERTIONS AND CHANGES

A. The following section or part thereof denoted in the section number is added, with such addition being denoted by the word “**NEW**” preceding the additions.

B. The following section or part thereof denoted in the section number is changed, with such changes being denoted by underlining the changes.

SECTION 2. BODY OF ORDINANCE

Section 15-207. No Truck Traffic on Certain Streets. [Ord. 2004-4, 3/4/2004, § 2]

Section 15-207(3) Prohibition of trucks on certain roadways.

A. Based on engineering and traffic studies performed by the Township and pursuant to Title 75, § 4902(b), the Township hereby prohibits truck traffic from traveling on the following roadways:

Street

Restricted Area

Blue Barn Road
Chapmans Road
Grange Road
Krocks Road
Lone Lane
Schantz Road

Schantz Road to Oak View Drive
Memorial Road to Township line
Cetronia Road to Ruppssville Road
Cetronia Road to Schantz Road
Cetronia Road to Schantz Road
Ruppssville Road to Cetronia Road

“NEW”

B. Based on engineering and traffic studies performed by the Township and pursuant to Title 75, § 4902(b), the Township hereby imposes certain height restrictions on vehicles, trailers and apparatus travelling the following roadways:

Street	Height Restriction	Restricted Area
Schantz Road	Eleven (11') Feet	Ruppsville Road to a distance 1,050 feet west

SECTION 3.

It is declared that the enactment of the Ordinance is necessary for the protection, benefit and preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Township.

SECTION 4.

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith shall be and the same expressly are repealed.

SECTION 5.

This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon adoption by the Board of Supervisors.


SECTION 6.


