AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF UPPER MACUNGIE, LEHIGH COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 21, PART 7, SECTION 702 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF UPPER MACUNGIE TOWNSHIP, PROVIDING FOR THE CHANGING NAMES OF EXISTING STREETS, ALL OF WHICH IS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF 53 PURDON'S STATUTES SECTION 67329.

SECTION 2. BODY OF ORDINANCE

PART 7 CHANGING NAMES OF EXISTING STREETS AND ALLEYS

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith shall be and the same expressly are repealed.

SECTION 5.


This Ordinance shall be effective five (5) days after its passage by the Board of Supervisors.


