A special meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Upper Macungie Township was held on July 21, 2016, at 7:00 PM, in the Municipal Building at 8330 Schantz Road, Breinigsville, PA 18031. Those present were Chairman, James M. Brunell; Secretary, Kathy A. Rader; Township Manager, Daniel P. Olpere.

ORDINANCE – 2016-01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF UPPER MACUNGIE, LEHIGH COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 21, PART 7, SECTION 702 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF UPPER MACUNGIE TOWNSHIP, PROVIDING FOR THE CHANGING NAMES OF EXISTING STREETS, ALL OF WHICH IS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF 53 PURDON'S STATUTES SECTION 67329.

Name Change – Krocks Road to North Krocks Road from the Upper Macungie Township line, with Lower Macungie Township, north, to its intersection with Cetronia Road.

Upon a motion by Chairman Brunell, seconded by Secretary Rader and unanimous, Ordinance 2016-01 is hereby adopted.
