

Additional Park Usage Rules & Facts

1. Parks are open from dawn to dusk.
2. Due to uncontrollable circumstances, the park may be closed down by one of the Township officials without prior notice.
3. Vehicles must be kept on the paved areas. Parking or driving on the grass is prohibited.
4. Phone reservations will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.
5. Rental fees include cleaning up before and after, and stocking the pavilion restrooms.
6. Clean-up crews start between 6:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. the day of the rental.
7. Amplified audio equipment can only be used between 8:00 a.m.–9:00 p.m. with special permission.
8. Lights are operated by an automatic timer.
9. It is prohibited to put nails, screws, push pins or staples in the wood at the pavilions.
10. Pavilion and picnic tables must be returned to the condition and position that your party found them.
11. The pavilion must be vacated by 9:00 p.m. at all parks except Upper Macungie Park–Rt.100 (11:00 p.m.)
12. Cancellations for full refund require 31 days notice.
13. Refunds will not be issued in case of inclement weather.
14. **Pavilion rentals are for pavilions only. Athletic fields require separate application and permits.**

Reservation & Permits Information

- **Pavilion reservation and athletic field permits** are available after January 1st of each year. Forms can be found online or at the Upper Macungie Township administrative building, and they can be mailed or dropped off at UMT building. (Monday–Friday, 7:30 a.m.–11:30 a.m. or 12:30 p.m.–4:00 p.m.)
- Pavilions can be reserved April through October (no restroom facilities during other months). Call UMT to place a 5 business day hold (30 days for businesses) on the date until your application is processed. The payment can be made by cash, check or money order made payable to “UMT”.

There are currently 10 parks serving UMT families. These parklands comprise nearly 475 total acres and are located throughout Upper Macungie Township offering easy access from all of our neighborhoods.

To protect our parks, the following activities are NOT PERMITTED:

- Alcohol and/or drugs
- Camping
- Commercial use
- Defacing buildings and/or vegetation
- Dogs without a leash (except Dog Park)*
- Driving or chipping golf balls (except Independent Park golf course)
- Fireworks
- Gambling
- Hunting/trapping
- Littering of any kind
- Loitering or disorderly conduct
- Peddlers
- Solicitation
- Swimming/ice skating
- Vehicles on the grass

* If walking your pets, please be sure to clean up after them.

CAUTION: Playground equipment may cause injury.

- NO bare feet
- NO throwing sand or any other objects within play areas
- NO playing on equipment when it is wet
- Children must be accompanied by an adult at all times!

Apple Park

1935 Packhouse Road, Fogelsville • 18.2 acres

Nestled in a development off North Church Street.

- **Large Field** for soccer, field hockey & lacrosse – Reservation permits available

Blue Barn Park

5770 Snowy Orchid Lane, Allentown • 1.96 acres

Located in the Pennfield Place East Development.

- **Basketball Court** – fenced on 4 sides
- **3 Tennis Courts** – fenced on 4 sides with meshing to help block wind

Church Street Park

South Church Street, Fogelsville • 2 acres

Fenced off along roadway, this park includes a large flat grassy area for games and activities.

 - First-come, first-serve

Fogelsville Dam Park

Haasadahl & Hilltop Roads, Fogelsville • 50.7 acres

This park features a hiking trail through woods above the Hassen Creek. Various waterfowl inhabit the area.

- **Mulched Walking Path** through woods
- **Benches**
- **Fishing** is permitted in accordance with current Pennsylvania Fishing Laws
- Climbing on dam is prohibited

Parking: Limited parking near dam on Haasadahl Road and also on Hilltop Road at gravel lot

Earl Adams Memorial Park (Breinigsville Park)

8935 Breinigsville Road, Breinigsville • 24.3 acres

This modern facility includes a large playground, pavilions, volleyball courts and walking paths, as well as a set of three baseball fields utilized by local organizations. Park entrance is located at Butz and Breinigsville Roads.

- **2 Pavilions** with picnic tables, electrical outlets, lights on timer, charcoal grills
 - Capacity: 100 people each
 - Reservation permits available
 - (All day rental fee: \$100 resident; \$150 non-resident)
- **2 Baseball Fields** – Reservation permits available

Lone Lane Park

30 Lone Lane, Allentown • 17.4 acres

Located at Schantz Road and Lone Lane between the Windermere and Kraft Village Developments. The large playground offers active play components, and a large open grassy area for games and activities. The oversized pavilion is suitable for gatherings.

- **Pavilion** with picnic tables, electrical outlets, lights on timer, charcoal grill
 - Capacity: 300 people
 - Reservation permits available (All day rental fee: \$125 resident, \$175 non-resident)

- **9-Hole Pitch-And-Putt Golf Course** – Ideal for starters or short-game practice, course play is FREE from dawn to dusk.
- **Independent Park Community Center** – An impressive venue for family, social or corporate events, this contemporary facility features a grand entranceway, cathedral ceilings, 2-story stone fireplace, wraparound deck, and expansive views of the rolling countryside from inside and out. Multiple event rooms and kitchen facilities can be booked 2 years in advance.

This park is located between Ruppssville Road and Rt. 222 bypass across from the Olde Towne Development.

Upper Macungie Park–Rt. 100

1625 North Rt. 100, Fogelsville • 156.2 acres

Located between Rt. 100 and an old stone quarry, this park offers a variety of sports fields and a nature trail which is a quiet retreat. The scenic view of the quarry is a great spot for bird watchers. The Dog Park provides an exercising/socializing area for canines and their owners.

- **2 Pavilions** with picnic tables, electrical outlets, lights on timer, charcoal grills – Falcon Pavilion by the road and Hawk Pavilion by the woods
 - Capacity: 100 people each
 - Reservation permits available (All day rental fee: \$100 resident; \$150 non-resident)
