


On-Lot Sewage Management Update

Sewage System Inspections Mandatory in 2018 for District 3 Properties



This is a program to monitor the proper function of UMT owners' on-lot sewage systems to protect our water table and overall environment. It is a staged program which is mandated by the PA Department of Environmental Protection and implemented by municipalities.

This ordinance provides a staged program by dividing the township into three districts. The residents in District 2 met all requirements with no complications in 2017. In early February, District 3 property owners were mailed a letter, form, and District map as a reminder to have their septic

systems cleaned and inspected by a registered Pumper/Hauler before December 31, 2018. In 2019, District 1 will receive the same reminder letter.

Scheduled maintenance of on-lot septic system helps reduce high costs incurred by property owners should their septic system fail, but ultimately protects and maintains a healthy environment for future generations.
